YAS Policy Agreement-Summer 2021

(Please Read Carefully)

Refund Policy

No refund of tuition will be made after **May 15, 2021**. Students will receive a full refund of tuition, minus a \$75 processing fee, if they remove themselves from the workshop before **May 15, 2021**. No refunds of tuition will be given to cast members removed from the cast by YAS staff for behavioral reasons.

Parent Commitment

Take a break this summer! No parent committees. We will ask that you provide items such as hand sanitizer, a hat, masks, sunscreen, and a towel for your cast member. Please read and keep up to date with all of our emails. Please read and become familiar with our COVID-19 safety plan.

Costumes:

We will ask families to provide their own costumes and certain accessories, which could be as simple as modern summer camp attire. Details and suggestions will be provided.

Absences:

No conflicts are allowed. Attendance is very important. This is an intensive 2-week filming session. Filming will take place throughout the 2-week process. Missing any day or part of a day could mean missing your shooting session. If a cast member is absent they will not be part of the shot we are filming, which could affect the whole project. If you are absent due to COVID-19, makeup filming dates will be scheduled for your solo shots in the scenes that are possible. Not all scenes may be rescheduled, but we will do all we can.

Late Pick Up

It is very important to pick up your child from rehearsal as scheduled. There will be no charge for the first 10 minutes late for pick-up. More than 10 minutes will result in a late pick-up fee of \$1 per minute.

Disciplinary Process

Cast members and their parents must be aware that rehearsals can be strenuous and require cast members to have the ability to focus for long periods of time. Cast members will be given warnings for the following: disruptive, disrespectful, or destructive behavior, repeated failure to listen, failure to follow directions, or failure to participate in rehearsals. Incident 1) Verbal warning to the child; Incident 2) Meeting with cast member and parent to discuss possible dismissal from the program. Certain extreme negative behavior (fighting, physical intimidation, verbal harassment or otherwise) may warrant an immediate dismissal upon the discretion of the Director.

Check e-mail

All communication is done via e-mail. Parents must commit to checking their e-mail for any changes and updates regarding the production. An accurate e-mail address must be provided.

Additional Rehearsals:

Additional virtual rehearsals may be scheduled as needed.
